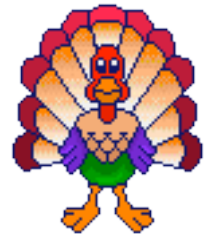
I hope to see all of you at our Christmas Social on December the 8th. I know this will be another fun time and a great community event.
