## Architectural Control Committee

As soon as wind & weather has "cleaned" our trees, we need to **clean our gutters** filled with pine needles and leaves. Debris left in gutters combined with snow that repeatedly freezes, thaws, expands can cause damage to shingles and possible leaks. **Clean drain pipes** to insure good flow. Also, add an extension if necessary, to have water flow well away from the foundation. Don't forget to **disconnect your hoses**. The faucet pipe inside the wall does not completely drain when the hose remains connected, Freezing temps can crack the pipe resulting in a wet mess inside your home when warmer weather returns. **October 15** is the deadline for removing window air conditioners.
